WAYS HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS CAN PREVENT OVERDOSE

6 SIMPLE STEPS FOR LIFESAVING IMPACT

STEP 1

Ask about overdose

Experiencing previous overdose is the greatest risk factor for subsequent overdose.1,2

STEP 2

Prescribe buprenorphine

Individuals on MOUD have a lower risk of overdose and overdoserelated mortality.3

STEP 3

Prescribe naloxone with every encounter

High coverage of naloxone is associated with a reduction in overdose.4

STEP 4

Watch for abstinence

Recent release from abstinence-based treatment or incarceration are associated with increased rates of overdose mortality.5

STEP 5

Screen for polysubstance use & avoid benzodiazepines

Polysubstance use, especially benzodiazepines, are associated with increased rates of overdose mortality.6

STEP 6

Get educated on overdose prevention sites

Overdose prevention sites have been associated with reduction in overdose mortality.7
